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INVESTIGATOR TOOLKIT

GRANT WRITING AND PROGRESS REPORTS

Familiarity with granting agencies, particularly NIH and CIRM, is one of SEN's core competencies. In addition to grant writing, we can research grant prospects for you, establish contacts within funding agencies, and keep you up-to-date on deadlines and policy changes. We can also help you plan, write and submit progress reports.

MANUSCRIPT EDITING AND WRITING MENTORSHIP

Collectively we have over 30 years of experience fashioning journal-ready prose from first draft manuscripts. 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FEE STRUCTURE FOR CORE SERVICES 2015

SEN offers the following services, either individually or in concert, to assist investigators or institutions in the preparation of manuscripts for publication or for submission to a granting agency. We work closely with clients at all stages of the process, from concept development to proofreading and manuscript submission. While investigators are ultimately responsible for the manuscript and its content, we can help reduce the headaches surrounding paper and grant writing. Our goal is to highlight the creative and groundbreaking aspects of a research project using writing that is simple, clear and jargon-free.

COPYEDITING AND DOCUMENT PREPARATION. RATE \$80/HR

Copyediting is done right before a manuscript goes out. It is a check for spelling mistakes, typos, formatting errors, and grammatical mistakes. We also review figures, ensuring that they are appropriately referenced in the figure legend and text. Copyediting usually progresses at the rate of 4 pages/hr for documents that we have not read before, and 10 pages/hr for documents that we have edited.

DEVELOPMENTAL EDITING, GRAPHIC ART, WEB DESIGN. RATE \$80-120/HR*

This fee covers two different activities: online or other forms of research and data collection, and editing of a grant or paper after the outline is complete and the first draft is done. We edit a manuscript's organization, style, grammar and formatting; we also provide detailed comments on content and figures. An average short-format paper takes between 10 and 25 hours.

GRANT WRITING. RATE \$120-180/HR*

Working closely with investigators, we help design an outline for the project based on the investigators' results and their desired aims. A rough draft is created, and modified by the investigator and the editor until the client is happy with the draft. The manuscript can then move to the editing phase. Although we can provide advice regarding experimental design, presentation of data, and potential aims of the work in question, investigators must be the primary creative and motivational force behind the manuscript.

References and figure making are not generally included in our grant writing service. Most investigators handle the references and citations themselves, as they are most current on the state of their field. They also prefer to make their own figures, since they have easier access to the data. However, these services can be provided on request.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT AND CONSULTING. RATES VARY.

*Fees vary by project, and reflect both the experience of the editor and the nature of the work. We can provide academic discounts.
